1. Scholarship Application: To submit for a new scholarship from the Doughboy Chapter please follow the guidance that is listed on the national website for the USAWOA. Our Chapter will use the same standards and process as the national association, so you can submit for a NJ Doughboy Chapter and also for the National Scholarship program.

2. Who can submit application: This is our first year we are accepting applications for our Doughboy Chapter. Any current member of the Chapter as of 1 January 2011 is allowed to submit an application. Any current spouse of a member can also submit an application. Any Child of a member is also authorized to submit an application. If a retiree has grandchildren who will be attending an approved school is also authorized to submit an application. The Scholarship committee reserves the right to request additional information or disapprove the application, if the committee feels the application does not qualify for consideration.

3. Scholarship: This year our scholarship will be \$500.00 for two years. The awardees will have a \$500.00 scholarship sent to their school each year, provided they successfully complete the first year, pass, then starts the second year of class.

4. Qualifying schools: Higher education institutions with at least a 2 year program, Technical Schools, Community Colleges, Universities & schools that provide a license to work in your chosen field.
